Application Checklist:

- STATE DEGREE must be completed by graduation
 - If not, please include with your application an explanation as to why you were unable to obtain your State Degree along with your FFA activities.
- LETTER OF REFERENCE from an employer, community member, mentor, etc. must be included with application.
 - Must NOT be from a family member.
- A copy of your COMPLETE RECORD BOOK REPORT from THEAET.COM, completed and up to date, must be included with application.
- A current typed resume must accompany the application.
- A minimum 2.5 GPA is required for eligibility.
- For your application to be considered, it must be completed in its entirety, including all signatures required, a letter of reference, and a copy of your record book report.
- Applications must be submitted complete and received on/postmarked by the Friday before Troy High School Spring Break via email or mail to:

- Optional preliminary application review is available, by alumni members and arranged by FFA advisor, approximately 2 months prior to application due date, date tbd.
- If you are approved for a scholarship, you are responsible for contacting the Scholarship Committee (above address) with your current mailing address, proof of enrollment and current or upcoming course schedule by Oct 1. Please include your Student

ID number. SCHOLARSHIP WILL NOT BE AWARDED UNTIL RECEIPT OF VERIFICATION OF ENROLLMENT.
